**Position:** Field Organizer

Conservation Voters of South Carolina Education Fund (CVSCEF) is a statewide conservation nonprofit supported by South Carolinians who are committed to protecting our state's air, land, and water. We are dedicated to maximizing the participation of conservation-minded citizens in public policy decisions made at the state and local levels to protect our environment and natural resources.

In 2018, CVSCEF is launching an ambitious statewide campaign to reform energy policy in South Carolina and build a clean energy future. The core of our campaign is to take advantage of the current political climate to bring more conservation voters into our movement and ignite the next generation of conservation advocates. We are currently looking to fill several roles on our campaigns field team, so this is a great opportunity to work on the ground floor.

### **The position:**

The field organizer will work closely with our partner, Exposure Labs, to experiment with a new model of community engagement through film. Building off the momentum from their latest award-winning film, [Chasing Coral](#), this position will explore ways to use films to mobilize strategic communities across the state.

Your responsibility will include:

- **Community outreach.** Identifying opportunities for strategic local partnerships. Engaging local networks to identify screening hosts and execute community screenings and facilitated dialogues, with a focus on conservative, faith-based, and business communities in South Carolina.
- **Community management.** Expanding CVSCEF's network of conservation advocates and deepening our existing relationships through events and one on one meetings. Recruiting volunteers and empowering them with the tools and training they need to become the next generation of conservation advocates.
- **Finding local stories.** Assisting CVSCEF and its partners in identifying opportunities for video testimonials and short film content that demonstrate citizens' support for the campaign.

- An entrepreneurial spirit with a creative approach to engage communities and plan events
- Strong organizational skills and experience working with volunteers
