



**Conversation Voters of South Carolina – Field Organizer
Temporary Contract Position for May – June (may begin earlier)**

Conservation Voters of South Carolina is the political voice of South Carolina's environmental community. CVSC is a bipartisan, non-profit organization that, along with its related Political Action Committee, elects pro-conservation candidates to the State Legislature, advocates for the passage of laws that protect our environment, and holds elected officials accountable “to protect the South Carolina we love.” We fight for our air, land, and water through bipartisan and pragmatic political action.

Scope of Position: CVSC seeks multiple individuals with interest and/or experience in electoral politics to serve as part of CVSC’s 2022 political field team. These positions will help to implement various phone and door-to-door field activities as part of multiple independent campaigns for State House elections. The ideal individuals are those with a passion for politics and conservation, a can-do attitude, and a willingness to engage strangers in conversations for persuasion purposes.

These organizers will report to CVSC’s Strategic Partnerships Director and work closely with CVSC’s Executive Director and political team to implement our election goals.

Location: multiple positions are available throughout the state, with a focus on Greenville County and the Upstate, York and Lancaster Counties, and Charleston County and the Lowcountry. Daily travel will be required.

CVSC anticipates hiring 9-10 contract organizers for the team.**

Specific Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Door-to-door canvassing
- Phone canvassing
- Engaging current CVSC members and activists to volunteer at events
- Raising overall awareness of CVSC and CVSC issues

Qualifications

- A passion for conservation and environmental efforts to protect our air, land, and water
- Sales experience, political experience, door-to-door or phone experience, and other experience cold-contacting a wide range of individuals for persuasion purposes
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Strong organizational skills



- Experience working with volunteers
- Ability to multi-task and prioritize a number of campaigns/projects
- Team player with excellent collaboration skills
- Ability to work under pressure with tight deadlines
- Ability to work nontraditional hours, including some weekends
- Reliable transportation will be required throughout the day during work days.
- A smart phone and cellular data will be required for data entry and data tracking.

Work environment: CVSC is a mission-driven organization whose staff are deeply passionate about advancing environmental policy in a just and equitable way. We are seeking temporary contractors who can be effective, productive, enjoyable and highly ethical partners for CVSC and who will take responsibility and leadership for implementing tasks to further our electoral goals.

Terms of contract: The positions are contract positions.

The estimated amount of work is approximately 6-8 hours a day, with flexible scheduling opportunities based on the needs of the campaign and voters being targeted. Contractors should plan on working mid-day to early evening (7pm) on Tuesday-Friday and during the day on Saturdays to maximize voter contacts.

Regular in-district travel will be required each day – both to/from an area as well as travel during the work day. A smart phone and cellular data will be required for data entry. Occasional out of town travel may be required if needs arise in other districts.

CVSC is an organization committed to a racially just, equitable and inclusive workplace and encourages all individuals to apply.

Stipend/Compensation: CVSC will offer a \$2,000 per month stipend as an independent contractor, plus a monthly travel allowance.
